Dear: Col Kelly:

The Rivers Coalition met on July 22, 2021 and endorsed the following position:

We request the Army Corps of Engineers optimize Alternative CC by further reducing harm to the St. Lucie estuary.

Any Lake Okeechobee regulatory releases to the St. Lucie above 0 cfs represent harm, and for that reason it's critical to keep S-308 flows to a minimum in the Lake Okeechobee System Operating Manual (LOSOM).

To accomplish this, we request the Army Corps:

- Remove Zone F and lower Zone D down to the water-shortage management line, in order to send more water south during the dry season and send beneficial dry-season flows to the Caloosahatchee. Use this extra capacity to reduce damaging high lake stages and high-volume discharges to both the St. Lucie and Caloosahatchee estuaries.
- · Maintain 0 discharges to the St. Lucie in Zone D.
- Do everything in the Corps' power to avoid increasing regulatory releases above volumes proposed in Alternative CC as currently drafted.
- Address algal-bloom risk to the estuaries by incorporating operational flexibility that allows the Army Corps not to discharge when doing so would risk transferring algae from Lake Okeechobee to the estuaries.
- Work closely with the South Florida Water Management District to ensure southward flows aren't needlessly constrained by outdated water-supply assumptions
